FINANCIAL CONTRACT

A non-refundable application fee of \$25.00 is payable with the return of this application. After a student is accepted, a deposit of \$575.00 is required to secure the child's enrollment. If an enrolled student withdraws before June 15 (prior to the school year), the deposit is refundable. If the student withdraws after June 15, the deposit is non-refundable. Enrollment and tuition are for the entire school year, September to early June. Pro-ration or refund of any part of the annual tuition is determined based on extenuating circumstances and approved by the Head of School.
