Dear Valued Guest,

As the host of your golf outing, please pass on the following policies and procedures to your guests. This will help avoid confusion pertaining to our policies and will help avoid any possible conflicts. By following these policies, this will allow our staff to provide the smoothest and most memorable experience for you and your guests.

## Golf Outing - Policies and Procedures

### Bag Drop

- The bag drop is located at the end of Kinloch & Fox. Signage is posted to direct you. Western staff will unload your bags upon arrival and will stage them on the appropriate cart in a timely manner. Once you have dropped your golf bag, you may proceed to the Valet located in the circle drive at the main entrance of the clubhouse.

### Parking

- Valet parking is INCLUDED with your golf package. Valet parking will be located at the main entrance on Kinloch Road. Tipping is *not included* so please be considerate to your valet attendant when departing.

### Locker Rooms

- Guest lockers with keys are available in both the Men's and Ladies Locker Rooms

### **Proper Attire on the golf course and in the clubhouse is required at all times.**

- Men – Proper golf slacks or shorts. Denim, cut-offs, tennis shorts, cargo slacks or cargo shorts are NOT appropriate apparel. Collared shirts are required and must be tucked in. Mock turtleneck shirts are allowed, NO tee shirts.
- Women – Proper golf slacks, shorts or skirts. Shorts or skirts must be within 5 inches of the knee. Denim, cut-offs, tennis shorts, cargo slacks or cargo shorts are NOT appropriate apparel. Tops should have collars if they have no sleeves or sleeves if they have no collars.
- *Guests in violation of the dress code will be directed to rectify the problem in the golf shop or asked to leave the premises.*

### Pace of Play

- Outings will be allowed a maximum playing time of **5 Hours**. After this time has elapsed, WGCC reserves the right to close the course and ask the patrons to proceed to the designated food & beverage area.
