1:00-1:45	Marble Maze	Primary Class	Build a maze with a paper plate and strips of paper. See how far you can get your marble to travel along and through your maze.
1:30-2:15	Absorb Yourself in Absorption	Kindergarten Class	Discover the usefulness of water-absorbing polymer crystals in everyday life. Then by using those crystals, witness how the three primary colors gradually blend to create a rainbow contained in the palm of your hand.
