JAPHET SCHOOL PROVIDES SHRED TRUCK ON NOVEMBER 11

Metro Detroit Residents and Businesses Shred & Recycle to Raise Funds for Award-Winning School

Clawson, Michigan - Japhet School, the award-winning school in Clawson, is partnering with ShredCorp on November 11 to raise funds for the school by offering local businesses and residents the chance to shred and recycle boxes of documents at a minimum donation of \$5 per banker's box. The shred event is well timed with SOCRRA's shredding services temporarily closed.

The shred truck will be parked in Japhet School's lot on Saturday, November 11, from 9 AM to 12 PM. The school welcomes everyone in the community to bring documents to shred. ShredCorp's trucks are certified by the National Association of Information Destruction.

"Not only does this event raise funds for a great school," says Kevin Smith, member of the Japhet School Parent Support Group, "It also provides businesses and individuals with an opportunity to protect their assets and maintain compliance with sensitive information laws."

"Japhet School keeps tuition reasonable for its families, offers merit scholarships, and provides need-based financial aid," says Japhet's Head of School Cathy Mohan. "Tuition income alone accounts for only 70% of the school budget. To bridge the gap, the school must raise funds annually. Individual contributions and fundraisers such as the Japhet School Community Shred Event help meet that need."
