

Ordering “Japhet Blues” School Uniforms

Japhet School students in Kindergarten through Upper Class wear “Japhet Blues” every Monday, and on some field trips or for special events. Japhet Blues consist of:

Blue shirt with Japhet School logo and khaki bottoms

Students may wear layers of Japhet Blues. We recommend that all students have a short-sleeve collared Japhet shirt as a minimum, which may be worn alone or on top of a long-sleeve shirt for warmth.

Uniforms must be worn every Monday, beginning the first Monday of October. They must be the outer layer and may not be covered up on Mondays with a non-branded hoodie or sweater. Many students also have Japhet Blues fleeces for cold months.
