We appreciate your support of our current 18 Reasons for Hope campaign and thank you for your continuing generosity. 18 Reasons echoes our 18 character qualities and is our primary development campaign. It's success is vital to Japhet's day to day operations and supports the academic environment. We are grateful for you, our Japhet family, for helping to make it a success.

Japhet School is an accredited school through ISACS, the Independent Schools Association of the Central States. Accreditation is a seven-year

cycle, and we completed our accreditation review in 2019. We are pleased to report that we have received full re-accreditation from ISACS.

Recently, Japhet "pivoted" again, reconfiguring classrooms and reorganizing learning levels. Our Pre-K program was strengthened and our Middle School program transitioned to a more integrated learning environment allowing for greater flexibility and a stronger academic experience. The addition of our new STEM lab provides a hands on approach to science, technology, engineering, and math. We are confident that these adjustments will have a big impact - elevating academic opportunities and preparing students for high school and beyond.

We are so delighted you have chosen to be a part of the Japhet family. It is only through the efforts of all stakeholders that Japhet can be truly successful. As can be seen by the closure of some of the other small private schools in the area in the recent past, this is not an easy task.
